Teacher's background and brief (教师及其简介):	Ms. Alexis holds a bachelor's degree from the University of California, San Diego and a master's degree from the University of London, School of Oriental and African Studies. Furthermore, she is a PhD student at the University of California, San Diego. Course brief and Description (课程简述):	In this fun and supportive class, students will create their own stories, poems, and characters while learning the basics of creative writing. Through games, prompts, and peer sharing, students build confidence, develop writing skills, and explore genres like fantasy, mystery, and adventure. This course is tailored for students in the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grades and complements California state standards for language arts. 在这个充满乐趣和支持性的课程中，学生将学习创意写作的基础知识，并创作自己的故事、诗歌和人物。通过游戏、提示和同伴分享，学生将建立自信，提升写作技能，并探索奇幻、悬疑和冒险等题材。本课程专为3、4、5和6年级学生量身定制，是对加州语言艺术标准的补充。		
Course Objectives (课程目标):	Students will receive feedback on three assignments throughout the semester. Two of the assignments will be individual feedback, while the third will be collaborative feedback from their peers. At the end of the term, students will be able to produce a short story or poem of their genre choice. 学生将在整个学期收到三项作业的反馈。其中两项作业将以个人反馈的形式进行，第三项作业将以同学合作反馈的形式进行。学期末，学生将能够创作一篇自己选择的体裁的短篇小说或诗歌。
